## Water-Soluble Fabric Finish

Fabric finish is necessary for certain fabrics to restore their original crispness and freshness. GELATONE Fabric Finish is a water-soluble fabric finish for professional application to drycleaned, wetcleaned and laundered fabrics. It is particularly effective in restoring the original look and feel to hard-to-finish fabrics such as cotton, linen, ramie, silk, and rayon.

Customers notice detail, and when the look and feel of their garments is improved, you can be sure they will appreciate it.

GELATONE Fabric Finish can be used in multiple applications including hand washing, top-loading (home-style) machines, front-loading (high-efficiency) machines and professional laundry and wetcleaning machines. It can also be applied using a spray method.

GELATONE is designed to work together with Street's H<sub>2</sub>PRO™ wetcleaning line for optimal cleaning and finishing results.

## Instructions for Using GELATONE® Fabric Finish

Use GELATONE Fabric Finish for fabrics requiring a firm hand or which are more difficult to press after processing in water, such as rayon, linen and cottons.

### **Hand Washing / Immersion Method**

1. Once fabric has been rinsed clean of detergent, in a clean sink or plastic pail, mix 4 ozs. GELATONE Fabric Finish for each gallon of rinse water and mix thoroughly.
2. Soak fabrics for approximately 1 to 2 minutes and lightly agitate by hand once or twice.
3. Carefully, but thoroughly, squeeze water out of fabrics. DO NOT wring fabric.
4. Dry and finish according to care label instructions.

### **Top-Loading (Home-Style) Washers**

1. Add GELATONE Fabric Finish at the start of the final rinse cycle, based on the appropriate water levels below:
  - For HIGH water level (full load), add 48 ozs. of GELATONE Fabric Finish
  - For MEDIUM water level (medium load), add 32 ozs. of GELATONE Fabric Finish
  - For LOW water level (small load), add 16 ozs. of GELATONE Fabric Finish
2. Dry and finish according to care label instructions.

### **Front-Loading (High-Efficiency) Washers**

1. Add GELATONE Fabric Finish to the appropriate dispenser at the start of the cycle, based on the appropriate load size below:
  - For FULL load, add 28 ozs. of GELATONE Fabric Finish
  - For MEDIUM load, add 20 ozs. of GELATONE Fabric Finish
  - For SMALL load, add 12 ozs. of GELATONE Fabric Finish
2. When the appropriate cycle has completed, dry and finish according to care label instructions.

### **Professional Laundry or Wetcleaning Machine**

Add GELATONE Fabric Finish at the rate of 2 oz. to 4 oz. per gallon of water used in the last rinse cycle (refer to machine manual for water equivalents).

*Note: Keep the ratio of water to fabric in the last rinse to a minimum, i.e. 1/4 gallon for each pound of fabric.*

### **Spray Method**

After cleaning, GELATONE Fabric Finish may be sprayed directly on fabrics either during or before pressing. If the fabric should dry before pressing, a light water spray at the press will provide the moisture necessary to relax wrinkles and ease finishing.

For spray application, mix GELATONE Fabric Finish concentrate with water in a ratio of 1:8. For example, add 3 pints (48 ozs.) GELATONE Fabric Finish to 3 gallons water for use in a 5 gallon spray tank. Adjust air pressure to give the desired spray pattern. Most users prefer a setting of 60 psig. Avoid higher pressures as excessive mist and overspray may result.

### **How to Order GELATONE Fabric Finish**

GELATONE Fabric Finish is sold by authorized Street's distributors everywhere. GELATONE Fabric Finish is available in single one-gallon containers, cases of four, 5-gallon pails or 15-gallon drums.
